

Supplementary Terms & Conditions

This document does not need to be signed between the seller ("Arboreal") and the customer ("Buyer") for every individual contract. But the Supplementary Terms & Conditions are applicable to ALL Arboreal Lumber Sales contracts between Arboreal and the Buyer, if a previous version of this document was signed by both parties.

The following document sets out the terms and conditions that must be included in the Letter of Credit provided by the Buyer. Please instruct your bankers accordingly. It also lists some common contractual terms not listed on Arboreal's official one-page Lumber Sales Contract.

CANCELLATION:

Letter of Credit (LC): If the Letter of Credit (LC) is not opened within 10 (ten) business days from the date of this agreement, Arboreal has the right to terminate this contract with immediate effect and without any liability from the Buyer.

Telegraphic Transfer (TT): If the advance prepayment (deposit), is not paid within 10 (ten) business days from the date of this agreement, Arboreal has the right to terminate this contract with immediate effect and without any liability from the Buyer.

FORCE MAJEURE:

It is agreed that if the seller is prevented by riots, strikes, lockouts or other commotion, or by war, earthquake, forest fire, exceptional rainfall, floods, or other extreme weather events that exceed normal and foreseeable limits for the geographical region, damage to regulation or decree from fulfilling this contract wholly or in a part, the party so prevented shall be relieved of the responsibility for supplying as the case may be the volume which is affected by the incident classified above.

DISPUTE:

All dispute arising in connection with the present contract shall be finally settled under the rules of conciliation and arbitration of the international chamber of commerce by one or more arbitrators appointed in accordance with the said rules in Uruguay.
